

He has contributed to debates on the political geographies of globalization and on the relations between resistance, space and politics. His work has also developed core concerns with subaltern political ecologies and the formation of transnational solidarity networks. He is the author of Solidarity. Hidden Histories and Geographies of Internationalism, Zed Books 2012.
